CLINICAL MEDICAL ASSISTANT PROGRAM

The Clinical Medical Assistant program offers outstanding, hands-on training for students looking to assist doctors and patients in physicians' private practices, clinics, and laboratories or other health service settings.

Clinical Medical Assistants involve clinical and administrative tasks, writing medical histories, recording vital signs, preparing patients for examinations or lab tests and may be asked to draw blood, administer injections or perform additional patient testing.

At the completion of the program, students are eligible to take the Certified Clinical Medical Assistant, Certified Phlebotomy (CPT) and Certified EKG (CET) exams nationally recognized by the National Healthcareer Association (NHA).

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

Our Pharmacy Technician program will provide you with the tools you need to become a successful professional in retail pharmacy, hospital, home healthcare settings, mail order or pharmaceutical wholesalers industry.

Pharmacy Technicians assist pharmacists in providing medications, drug information and healthcare products to patients. As a Certified Pharmacy Technician, you will receive, verify and prepare patient medications.
